Why are we moving to a new expenses system?

Moving to the new system will deliver significant cost saving for NHSBT as a whole, as well as reducing the number of systems we use.

The new system will have the similar functionality as the previous system, plus new functions such as:

- **Recommended route** The integrated Google maps function will provide you with the most time-effective route for your journey.
- Favourite Journeys You will be able to save your regular, or favourite, journeys making it quicker to claim your expenses.
- **New mobile app** The new mobile app allows you to record expenses whilst on the move, even where there is no mobile signal
- One System There will only be one system to record expenses, annual leave and absences.
- On Holiday function Approvers will be able to re-allocate their approval rights to another approver, during periods of annual leave.

Save your favourite or regular journeys making it quicker for you to claim your expenses. Use the integrated maps function to view the route for your journey.




Record and submit your expenses for travel up to 30th November in the current system.
